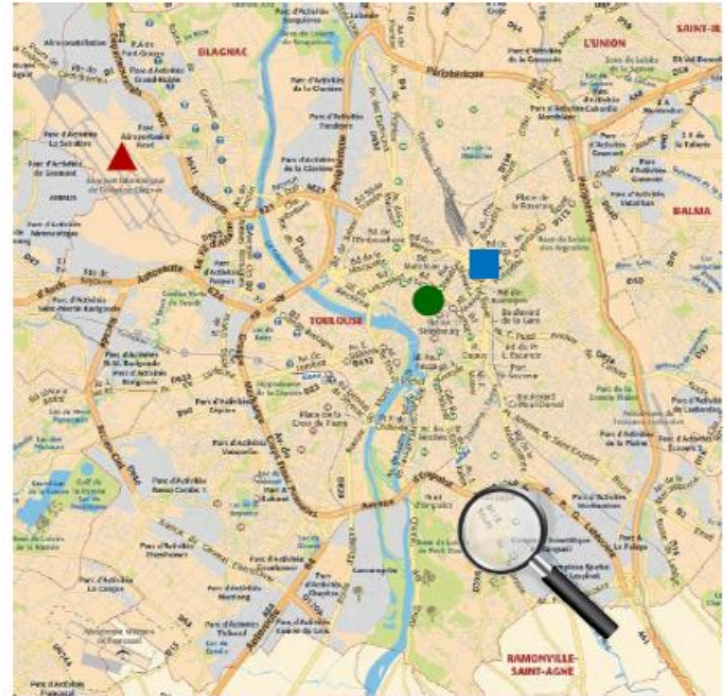
Information about the living cost
